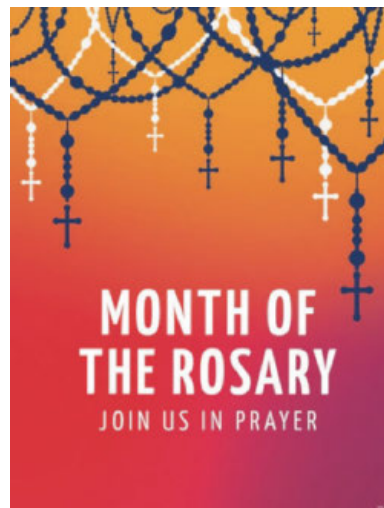

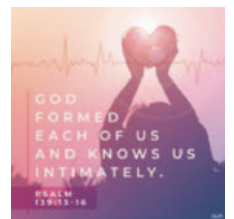
THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS – 10/13/24

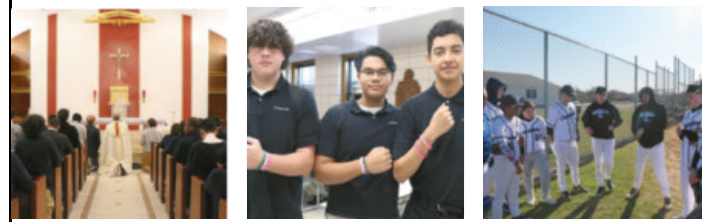

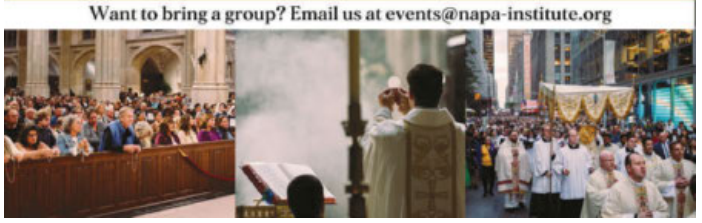

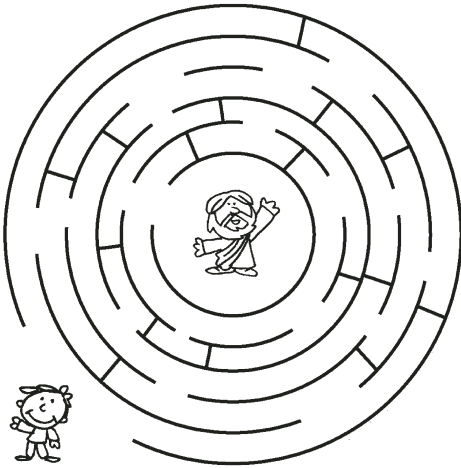
